FIFTH MIDWEST NATURAL AREAS WORKSHOP

September 29 - October 1, 1978

Babler Outdoor Education Center
Babler State Park, Chesterfield, MO

The 5th Annual Midwest Natural Areas Workshop will be held over the weekend of September 29 through October 1, 1978 at the new Babler Outdoor Education Center in Babler State Park in western St. Louis County. (See the enclosed map.) This year's workshop is being hosted by the Missouri Natural Area Survey (a program of the L-A-D Foundation) in cooperation with the Missouri Departments of Conservation and Natural Resources.

The workshop will begin at 1:30 pm on Friday, September 29th and will run through lunch on Sunday, October 1st. The cost for the lodging and food - beginning with Friday supper - will be \$28.00. This includes two nights lodging, six meals, coffee, linen. (Cost may be prorated for partial attendance.) The facilities at the Camp are quite comfortable and attractive.

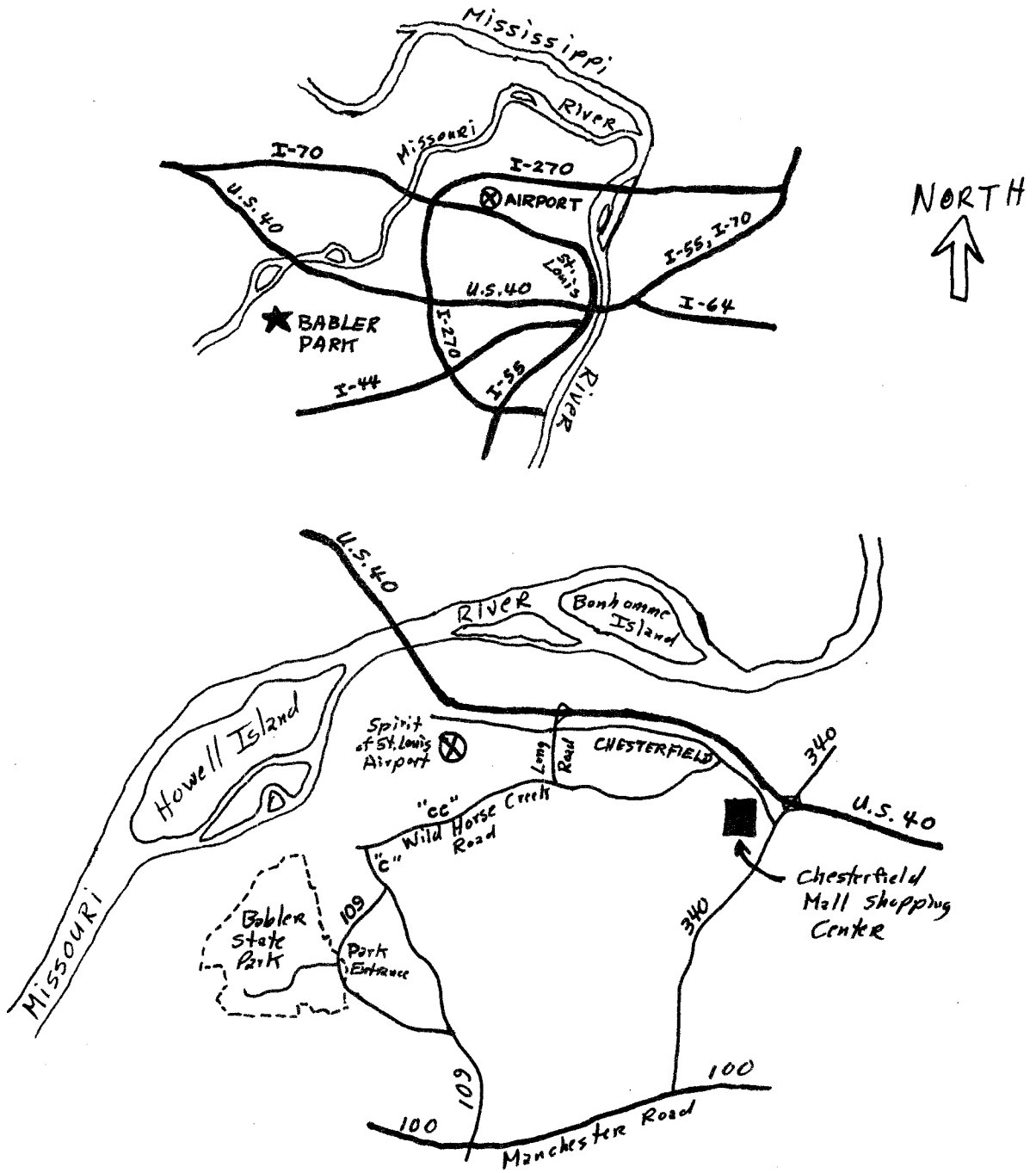

HOW TO GET TO THE BABLER OUTDOOR EDUCATION CENTER, BABLER STATE PARK, CHESTERFIELD, MISSOURI



DIRECTIONS: Take U.S. Highway 40 west from Interstate 270 (St. Louis Circumferential Highway) about 10 miles to the Chesterfield/Spirit of St. Louis Airport EXIT. As a guide this is the first exit west of Highway 340 (Chesterfield Mall Shopping Center Exit). Go due south on Long Road to Wild Horse Creek Road (County Route "CC"). Turn west (right). Stay on "CC" until you come to County Route "C" and turn south (left). (NOTE: There is a small gas station/food store on the southeast corner of the intersection of C and CC.) After a short distance, turn right on State Highway 109 (look for Babler Park sign). Highway 109 will take you to the entrance to BABLER STATE PARK. Once inside the park, follow the signs to the Outdoor Education Center for Handicapped (generally keep to the left).
